**You must adhere to the following rules to keep the parade safe and patriotic. Please check each box to indicate that you and other persons associated with your entry have read the rules and will follow them. Thank you!**

- No throwing of candy or other objects. Candy will be handed out prior to the start of the parade. Please adhere to this rule for the safety of the children. After the parade go to Jackson Park where there will be ice cream, bounce houses, face painting, BBQ meal and other fun things. Thank you!
- Horse rider(s) must have a **clean up person** as part of their entry.
- Please try to use the theme: **“My Best for My Country”** when decorating your entry. **We also ask that all entries be decorated with at least one American Flag and/or red, white and blue colors.**
- All drivers of motorized vehicles must possess a driver’s license.
- Motorcyclists must wear a helmet while riding their cycles in the parade.
- Stay in line and no racing your engines, squealing tires or unsafe driving.
- No riding on the hoods of vehicles or cabs. **Watch where you point your water gun.**
- Don’t litter along the parade route or in Jackson Park following the parade.
